## **2016 Annual Meeting Minutes May 18, 2016 Rosemont High Cafeteria**

President Terry Dugan opened the meeting at 7:00pm. A quorum of the membership was established.

The RCA and RCF Boards were introduced, as were the agency and program information tables that people were invited to visit and learn about their services.

Community Hero awards were given to Lupe Aldana who has been a steady volunteer at many RCA events; CHP Officer Tommy Riggin for his extraordinary help in Rosemont; and Savion Battle, a RHS Junior who does much volunteering on school campuses. The 2016 Volunteer of the Year Award was given to Doug Kenner for his leadership on the Kiefer Cleanup Crew as well as his organizing deep cleanups at the post office and Golden Empire School, and for his arranging classic car displays at the Celebration of Community.

The Nominating Committee report was given proposing the reelection of Dee Gavaldon, Gary Vorce, Anthony Osuna and Andrew Maalouf; and the election of Kim Sloan, Chris Peterson, Larnell Gill, and Don Jaczola to vacant positions. There were no nominations from the floor. It was moved and seconded to elect all proposed nominees; they were unanimously elected to the board by voice vote.

Dugan made a brief report, augmented by a written handout describing the year's works of RCA and RCF, what issues likely lie ahead for Rosemont, and the need for the community to begin considering what it wants its future to be and how to achieve it. This served to introduce the community workshop in which attendees shared and discussed what they wanted to see in Rosemont in the years ahead. After the workshop all the slips with people's ideas were collected and later compiled and published on line. Major themes of the comments dealt with safety, the conditions at the Plaza, and community appearance and reputation.

Supervisor Nottoli made remarks updating us on County plans and programs affecting Rosemont, and also presented a certificate to Doug Kenner. Assemblyman Ken Cooley, and Matthew Ceccato of Rep. Bera's office, and both presented certificates to Kenner as well. Also introduced were Christina Pritchett, SCUSD Trustee from Rosemont, and Capt. Michael Goold, our East Area SSD commander. All were available to answer questions from the attendees.

After a period of questions and answers, the meeting was adjourned at 8:50pm.
