Law enforcement

Deputy Sheriff Mike Matranga says no information is available on the body found near Tallyho

Director Vorce asked about snoopers looking through curbside recycling

4. Proposed Landfill Expansion – Mike Lien from L&D Landfill, 8635 Fruitridge

This is the site discussed by Mr. Jain at the October RCA meeting

It is a Class 3 material site, handling construction & demolition materials

They had an odor problem in early 90's

Looking to raise the site from 90' to 140' above mean sea level

Recycling materials since 1981

Wood and green waste go to be ground into fuel

Asphalt is easily separated & recycled

Over 100,000 tons of material is handled per year

Recycling is separated with household recycling going to Galt

A methane collection project is underway

The site is subject to about 20 agency's oversight

Tom Buford at the City of Sacramento can put one on mailing list for notice of such projects

The addition adds 7-8 years to the life of the landfill

Teichert is the landlord

A ring of trees will surround it, many growing now

They have a system to prevent seepage into groundwater

5. Cordova Community Planning Advisory Council (CORPAC)

The owner of a cell tower near Jackson Road wants to replace the 50' structure with a 109' one on a neighboring property

The Folsom/Bradshaw Arco proposal was withdrawn

6. Cordova Recreation & Park District (CRPD)

Rosemont Little League is giving money to the District to renew field, sharing labor

7. Schools

A new principal has been selected at Einstein School

The Homecoming Parade was a success

8. Finalize and Adopt Budget FY 2018-19

Director Mendoza explained some of the line items

Director Rutherdale moved to adopt the budget, seconded by Director Alexander Motion passed
