Developing a Neighborhood Watch Group Roster

A Neighborhood or Park Watch Roster contains the contact information of group members and is essential for a watch group to be effective. Knowing how to contact neighbors is essential. The roster is developed by the NW Coordinator and distributed to group members so they may contact one another about suspicious activity or when communicating general information to the entire watch group. Once the roster is finalized, a copy is given to each member of the watch group as well as the SCSO Crime Prevention Officer.
