Liz noted there were stolen items by porch pirates on several streets throughout Rosemont.

Students were smoking & were asked to get away from the fence one day prior to the incident. Fresh cheese was found at site the day the dog was beaten. RHS Principal notified.

 - Loud Bangs – people in dark SUV throwing fireworks out of car throughout Rosemont.

 - Man in wheel chair aggressively approached 8-year-old child by James Marshall Elementary School saying next time she had a problem with his daughter to talk to him. Child was shaken and crying. It was a mistaken identity. Reported to school.
